The president of the council shall be its presiding officer. Officers are elected for a term of four-two years, at which time the responsibilities shall be transferred to the officers of the Connectional Table, effective January 1, 2007. and shall continue until their successors are duly elected.

Amend ¶907.5 by deletion and addition

... the General Council on Ministries or effective January 1, 2007 the Connectional Table. It shall consist of twenty ten members of the General Council on Ministries.
