It falls during the season in which we remember the Resurrection and triumph of our Lord.

General Commission on Archives and History, General Council on Ministries and General Council on Finance and Administration acknowledged that more United Methodists are familiar with Aldersgate Day than with the union of the two denominations and would be more likely to celebrate their heritage on Aldersgate Day rather than on April 23.
