The purpose of the Bible study is to provide a reflective resource centering on our biblical identity for local churches and annual conferences to explore what Christ calls them to be and do and to fulfill Christ's mission in their lives and communities in the 21st century. The Bible study was to be developed collaboratively by the General Council on Ministries and the General Board of Discipleship and to be made available to the church in the 2001–2004 quadrennium. **Process and Implementation** From the outset, the Bible study was developed collaboratively by the two agencies. A joint writing team developed the Bible study, focusing on the five transformational directions of the Living into the Future proposal, as approved by the 2000 General Conference. Further, the Bible study sought to incorporate the Forums on the Future.
